To Whom It May Concern:

To begin the process of obtaining a well permit in Lehman Township, you must submit the following:

1. A well application completed and signed by the owner(s).
2. The well drillers name and address must be on the application.
3. A check for one hundred and fifty dollars (\$150.00) payable to Lehman Township.
4. Three copies of a plot plan drawn "to scale" showing the exact well location by the measured distances (in feet) to the two (2) closest property lines. The well "setbacks" must also be shown on the plot plan.

Any questions, please call the Lehman Township Sewage Enforcement Officer for a copy of the well ordinance.

Condition of approval:

The well must be located a minimum of one hundred (100) feet from any existing or proposed sewage disposal system. Also it may not be placed in any easement of said property without an approved variance from township.

Attach three (3) copies of an accurately scaled and dimensioned plot plan of the property showing all proposed and existing wells, septic tanks and septic beds on the subject property and/or within one hundred (100) feet of said property boundaries.

Well driller must submit, upon completion of the well, a drilling report of said well to the township with the date well was completed, depth of casing, depth of well, and gallons per minute.

Any changes in well location, as shown on plot plan, must be approved by township before moving well.

All isolation distances will be the responsibility of the land-owner and/or well driller.

This permit will become null and void if drilling is not commenced within three (3) years of the date of issuance and does not release the driller and/or land-owner from the responsibility of obtaining any and all additional permits as may be required by any Local, State or Federal agencies.

By accepting this permit, the applicant does accept all of the above conditions and agrees to fully comply therewith and further agrees that failure to comply with said conditions will result in an immediate and complete nullification of the said permit as issued with no further action by Lehman Township, or any official thereof.
