4. CHANGE ORDER REQUEST #3, LEHMAN TOWNSHIP PARK, PHASE 2 CONSTRUCTION PROJECT:

The Change Order #3 changes the project scope and contract time, and is as follows.

Remove twenty feet (20') of concrete curb @ \$22.50 per linear feet (\$450.00). Remove twenty feet (20') of guiderail @ \$44.35 linear feet (\$887.00). Add two (2) guiderail end treatments \$887.00. Remove bleachers (\$11,840.00). Add paving from proposed paving limits to existing maintenance garage 460 square yards of paving @ \$24.50 per square yard (2" 25mm base, 1.5" 9.5mm wearing) \$11,270.00. Pave the existing stone service entrance 250 square yards of paving @ \$24.50 per square yard (2" 25mm base, 1.5" 9.5mm wearing) \$6,125.00.

This is an increase in the Contract Price of \$5,105.00.

The contract time will extended sixty (60) days to Monday, December 28, 2015.
