MINUTES

Chairman John P. Sivick called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Also present was Richard C. Vollmer, Vice Chairman and Robert H. Rohner, Jr., Supervisor and Secretary/Treasurer. Robert F. Bernathy, Esq., Township Solicitor and Jon Tresslar, P.E., Township Engineer was not present.

PUBLIC COMMENTS:

A comment was received regarding an alleged zoning ordinance violation.

APPROVE THE MINUTES OF AUGUST 3, 2016:

Motion made by Mr. Vollmer and second of Mr. Rohner to approve the minutes of August 3, 2016 as presented. Unanimous.

AUTHORIZE THE PAYMENT OF THE BILLS ON LIST #1, LIST #2 AND THE TRANSFERS AS PRESENTED:

Motion made by Mr. Vollmer and second of Mr. Rohner to authorize the payment of the bills on List #1, List #2 and the transfers as presented. Unanimous.

ACCEPT THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS; ALL FUNDS, FOR THE MONTH ENDED JULY 31, 2016:

Motion made by Mr. Vollmer and second of Mr. Rohner to accept the financial statements; all funds, for the month ended July 31, 2016. Unanimous.

BID OPENING - ROAD MATERIALS:

Three (3) bids were received. Hanson Aggregates Pennsylvania, 209 Enterprises and Dingmans Ferry Stone.

The bid for 300 tons of gabion rock FOB Plant was awarded to 209 Enterprises at \$12.85 per ton for a total of \$3,855.00.

The bid for gabion rock Delivered was awarded to Hanson Aggregates Pennsylvania LLC at \$20.50 per ton for a total of \$6,150.00.

The bid for 500 tons of crusher run FOB Plant was awarded to Dingmans Ferry Stone, Inc. at \$6.50 per ton for a total of \$3,250.00, and Delivered at \$11.95 per ton for a total of \$5,975.00.

The bid for 500 tons of 3A stone FOB Plant was awarded to Dingmans Ferry Stone, Inc. at \$7.50 per ton for a total of \$3,750.00, and Delivered at \$13.15 per ton for a total of \$6,575.00.

The bid for 400 tons of blacktop FOB Plant was awarded to Hanson Aggregates Pennsylvania LLC at \$48.65 per ton for a total of \$19,460.00.

Motion for the above was made by Mr. Sivick, seconded by Mr. Vollmer. Unanimous.

ROAD MASTER/PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR:
