ADDENDUM NO. 1 – PEEC'S REQUEST FOR LETTER OF SUPPORT FOR A LSA GRANT APPLICATION:

Ed Winters stated that he was present, and representing PEEC's Executive Director Jeff Rosalsky.

PEEC will be submitting a LSA grant application for the construction of a sustainability lodge. This project proves to be more efficient than renovating seven (7) structures, which are the oldest remaining structures on the property. The new lodge will be a state of the art design by Peter Boland. Other than sleeping quarters, the lodge will have class rooms.

The cost is projected at \$1.7 million. Half of the cost will be covered by the National Park Services' Centennial Fund. PEEC needs to raise \$850,000. The LSA application will request \$250,000. The Pike County Economic Development Authority will be the grantee on behalf of PEEC.

Three (3) additional jobs will be created.
