1. THE TOWNSHIP HAS BEEN AWARDED A \$25,000 GRANT FROM THE PIKE COUNTY SCENIC RURAL CHARACTER PRESERVATION PROGRAM FOR THE TRAIN STATION PAVILION LOCATED IN THE BUSHKILL VILLAGE

Grant money comes from natural gas fracking. Those Counties with fracking activities that border Counties with no fracking activities are required to pay a percentage to those Counties.

PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR / ROADMASTER:

Timothy Rohner, Public Works Director / Roadmaster, reported repairs were done to the trucks and equipment, truck #912 had a recall and Gray Chevrolet completed the job, mowed all township site lines, clean up of recycling sites, met with Chemung Supply for guide rail repairs in township, mowed Annex, Ambulance building and park. Line painters through COG bid were notified and will be using Middle Smithfield for trucks and paint. Cleaned up wood in ditch lines on Winona Falls Road left from Treesmith's. Pothole repairs in township, started putting shoulders on West Sugar Mountain Rd. Dumpsters are being delivered for spring cleanup. Two trucks will be hauling black top with Middle Smithfield Township for paving at the Oak Grove site.
