PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR/ROADMASTER REPORT:

Tim Rohner, Public Works Director, reported working on trucks and equipment, cleaning up township recycling sites, township building, Pine Ridge, Tamiment, Ranchlands, work at Park. DBI finished painting lines on E. Sugar Mountain Road from VanWhy Road to Wickes Road for Leeward. Crew finished putting shoulders on new paved roads, mowing shoulders and picked up trash off township roads. Cut brush on Church Lane, E. Sugar Mountain Road and W. Sugar Mountain Road, Pine Ridge and 5A. Filled up water tank at community garden, fire extinguishers had yearly inspection from Cintas. Installed new stop signs at different locations in township. Grading shoulders in 5A.

Events: Last concert at the park on August 25th had a good turnout.

Tim Rohner attended the Road Task Force meeting on August 15th where there was discussion concerning the Rt 2001 project. Construction of a temporary road for traffic switch while the permanent road is being constructed.

A representative from Met-Ed met with Tim this morning at the park and discussed the elimination of transformers that are not needed. A transformer can be eliminated and a pole can be installed to run service to the Boy Scout building as well as a service line to the Ag building, which has two transformers that can be eliminated as well. A total of three transformers that are just burning power will be removed.

Robert Rohner stated that at the September 10th meeting bids will be opened for road materials and the cleanup day containers.
