ROADMASTER/PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR:

Tim Rohner, Roadmaster/Public Works Director stated that the crew has been addressing repairs and maintenance to the vehicles. Mowing of site lines. The cutting back of brush along the township's roads. The decks have been completed at the Annex (museum). Clean up from Friday's cleanup day. Picking up of litter along the township's roads. Installed new dump bodies on old truck #915 and new truck #915. Cleanup of the recycling sites at the municipal building, Pine Ridge and Tamiment. The repair to the gas pumps is completed. The bucket truck passed state inspection. Trees cut down at the community park. Roads were broomed due to the heavy rain storms. Class C training completed by the crew for fuel pumps. A new culvert pipe was installed on Brodhead Road. The new Peterbilt truck was lettered. Truck #910 was repaired and passed state inspection. Culvert pipe on East Sugar Mt. Road was filled with blacktop. Potholes were repaired throughout. Shoulders were mowed. Moved and set generator and propane tank for Pike County EMA at the Van Why Cell Tower site. The Pike County Road Task Force meeting was held over Zoom on September 17th. Work continues on the drainage cuts and fills on the State Route 2001 project. The detour is still in place for Sunset Lake Road.
