CALL THE MEETING TO ORDER:

Mr. Springs met with Chris Ingulli of the Conservation District to examine the culvert pipe on Brisco Mt. Road and discuss his suggestions regarding repairs. Mr. Ingulli suggested fully replacing the pipe since the township most likely will not be approved for the grant through the Conservation District due to the fact the price for repair will exceed the amount they will cover. Mr. Springs proposed applying for an emergency grant or emergency replacement of the pipe and would like to move forward with this option when Mike Lamoreaux submits plans.

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NEW BUSINESS:

1. APPROVE PURCHASE OF A NEW CATERPILLAR 305E2. SELLING PRICE \$61,200. TRADE-IN OF THE 2014 CASE SUPER N OF \$35,000. NET PURCHASING PRICE OF \$26,200.

Motion made by Mr. Springs and second by Mr. Rohner to purchase a new Caterpillar 305E2 for the net purchasing price of \$26,200. Unanimous

2. APPROVE FORWARDING THE ZONING AMENDMENT REGARDING SHORT-TERM RENTALS TO THE TOWNSHIP'S PLANNING COMMISSION AND THE COUNTY'S PLANNING COMMISSION.

PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR/ROADMASTER REPORT:

Work on trucks and equipment continues. The crew is still working on cleaning up the yard from clean up days. Truck #921 passed state inspection. Potholes have been filled at the north end of the township.

Work was done on the roof at the park. The brush and branches have been cut on Church Lane and a tree was cut on Brisco Mt. Road. Trash was picked up on the township roads. Brodhead Road was paved by Morrissey on October 8th & 9th. The shoulders on Brodhead Road and East Sugar Mt. Road were completed by Morrissey on October 14th & 15th. Line painting was completed on Brodhead Road and East Sugar Mt. Road. The recycling sites were cleaned up at the township building, Pine Ridge, and Tamiment. There was a good turnout for the dog training at the park on October 17th. There was a Road Task Force meeting on October 15th via zoom. Mr. Rohner was unable to attend due to the fact he was working on the project on East Sugar Mt. Road. The next meeting is scheduled for November 19th.

Wayne Witkowski asked about the status of the USDA Grant. Mr. Rohner responded saying they are waiting for the environmental report to come in.
